GOLF COURSE AND GYM UPDATE

The Association officially closed on the golf course on Friday, January 22, 2016. Renovations are beginning on all areas. Security was installed the first week in. All locks were changed, and we anticipate the key fob to the fitness center being installed in the next 30-45 days.

Renovations include updating the restrooms to become ADA compliant; replacing deteriorated wood, both interior and exterior, improving the bridal suite, creating an area for grooms quarters, and replacing the floor in the main kitchen.

Improvements to the golf course, other than cosmetic improvements, include adding or replacing sprinkler heads, removing and improving sand traps, aerification program for the fairways and greens and implementing a maintenance program. We have purchased new maintenance equipment. The greens are our primary focus.

The building housing the gym is under renovation. Limited new equipment will be purchased upon completion of renovation. In the interim, the gym is open "as is" daily from 6:00 am - 9:00 pm.

SATURDAY MORNING BREAKFAST

Breakfast at the Galley Grill will be suspended until May due to renovations of the kitchen and numerous scheduled events. We hope to resume the breakfast the beginning of May. Please watch the marquee for more information.

APRIL COMMUNITY GARAGE SALE Saturday, April 9, 2016 Rain Date April 16, 2016

Signs may be placed in the neighborhood on the day of the sale but must be removed by 4:00 pm.

Century 21 will continue Jan's legacy beginning with the October garage sale. There will be no maps for the April sale.

RESTRICTIONS AND GUIDELINIES PERTAINING TO: RV'S, TRAILERS AND BOATS

The restrictive covenants for each section of Newport state that "no boat, boat trailer, travel trailer, camp trailer, house trailer, or other similar property shall ever be stored on any lot, tract of parcel contained in Newport without the prior written approval of the Architectural Committee."

The Architectural Control Committee as a general rule allows boats and RV's to remain in a resident's driveway for a period not to exceed forty-eight (48) hours prior to leaving or returning from an outing. The boat, trailer or RV must remain out of public view at all other times.

SIGNS

The restrictive covenants for each section in Newport state "No signs, billboards, posters or advertising devices of any character shall ever be erected upon or allowed to exist on any lot, tract or parcel contained in Newport, without the prior written consent of the Architectural Committee.

The Architectural Control Guidelines permit:

- one (1) for sale or for rent sign not to exceed thirty-six (36) inches (exception golf course properties may have two (2) signs front and back yards).
- Home Security signs not to exceed twelve (12) inches.
- Contractor signs (must be removed within one week after completion of work).
- Political signs ninety (90) days before election see Guidelines size and restrictions.
- School Signs relating to student activities not to exceed six (6) square fee see Guidelines for additional requirements.

CHANGES AND REPAIRS TO THE EXTERIOR OF YOUR PROPERTY

Pursuant to the Declaration of Deed Restrictions and Covenants for each section in Newport, "no construction or erection of improvements upon any lot, tract or parcel contained in Newport, however classified, shall ever be commenced until the written approval of the Architectural Committee shall have been received."

Listed below are items that require ACC approval. This list is not all-inclusive:

- Construction or installation of any building, including sheds.
- Any addition to an existing building.
- Construction, installation or repair to any fence.
- Replacement of windows, gutters, wood, and siding.
- Exterior paint of any building located on your property.
- Removal of trees (except dead trees).
- Installation or replacement of walkways, driveways and/or extensions.
- Construction of any patio or addition to an existing patio.
- Replacement of roof (prior approval not required in event of an emergency, but home improvement request required with type of roofing material, etc.
- Flag poles.

Home Improvement Requests ("HIR") are available on our website under resident documents. A completed HIR along with a copy of your plot plan showing the location of your improvement is required. The ACC committee meets the first and third Friday of the month (exception - month with five Fridays or Holidays). HIR must be received the Wednesday before the meeting.

Paint chips are required for all painting (even if it is the same color of existing improvement).

LAKE & RIVER PERMITS BOAT LAUNCH PERMITS

Lake & River permits and Boat Launch permits expire December 31st of the year issued.

Grace period for 2015 permits extended to April 15, 2016.

Permits & renewals are available in the management office. The cost per permit (renewal or new issue) is:

Lake & River Permit—\$10 each (separate permit required for each person over 16 yrs of age)

Boat Launch—\$50

Cost to have key issued is \$30 (this is a one-time fee)
Lost key replacement \$100

PROPERTY TAXES

Information for new property owners and those property owners who will be 65 years of age or older in 2016. If you occupy your home on January 1, 2016 you are eligible for a homestead exemption on your property taxes. The standard exemption can save on an average approximately \$300 on your property taxes.

Over 65 and disability exemptions save considerably more. Request for exemptions need to be filed by April 30, 2016.




