CHANGES AND REPAIRS TO THE EXTERIOR OF YOUR PROPERTY

Pursuant to the Declaration of Deed Restrictions and Covenants for each section in Newport, "No construction or erection of improvements upon any lot, tract or parcel contained in Newport, however classified, shall ever be commenced until the written approval of the Architectural Committee shall have been received."

Listed below are items that require ACC approval. This list is not all-inclusive:

- Construction or installation of any building, including sheds.
- Any addition to an existing building.
- Construction, installation or repair to any fence.
- Replacement of windows, gutters, wood, and siding.
- Exterior paint of any building located on your property.
- Removal of trees (except dead trees).
- Installation or replacement of walkways, driveways and/or extensions.
- Construction of any patio or addition to an existing patio.
- Replacement of roof (prior approval not required in event of an emergency, but Home Improvement Request form required with type of roofing material, etc.
- Flag poles.

Home Improvement Requests ("HIR") are available on our website under RESIDENT DOCUMENTS. A completed HIR along with a copy of your plot plan showing the location of your improvement is required. The ACC committee meets the first and third Friday of the month (exception - month with five Fridays or Holidays).

HIR must be received the Wednesday before the meeting.

Paint chips are required for all painting (even if it is the same color of existing improvement).

LAKE & RIVER PERMITS BOAT LAUNCH PERMITS

Permits & renewals are available in the management office. Camping is permitted at both lake park and river park.

The cost per permit (renewal or new issue) is:

Lake & River Permit—\$10 each
(separate permit required for each person over 16 years of age)

Boat Launch—\$50

Cost to have key issued is \$30 (this is a one-time fee)

Lost key replacement \$100



POPCORN BALLS

Ingredients

- 2 cups sugar
- 1 1/3 cups water
- 1/2 cup light corn syrup
- 1 teaspoon white vinegar
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- 18 cups popped corn



Directions

In a medium saucepan, combine sugar, water, syrup, vinegar, and salt. Cook over high heat until mixture reaches 255 degrees F (<u>hard-ball stage</u>) on a <u>candy thermometer</u>. Stir in vanilla. Pour over popped corn, tossing gently to coat. When mixture is cool enough to handle, press popcorn into 3-inch balls with lightly greased hands. Cool completely on waxed paper.

BEWARE OF THE SCAMS

Scams seem to be occurring more often than not these days. Please be aware of the following:

- A call from a person identifying themselves as an IRS agent, stating that you owe a certain amount and that if you don't pay they will attach your bank account, take your home, car, etc.
- A call from a person stating that one of your relatives is in trouble in a foreign country or out of state and needs your help. They will tell you the relative does not want their parents to find out.
- A call from a person telling you that you have won a large amount of money but in order to collect the money you need to send them (usually by wire or credit card) a certain amount in order to receive your winnings.

None of these calls are legitimate.

Do not give any information to the caller or try to get information from them.

Just hang up.

FENCES ON PIPELINES


Recently our office was contacted by a representative from Sunoco Logistics, the successor to the owner(s) of the pipeline easements that run within Newport Subdivision.

Pipelines run through Sections One, Two, Three, Four, Five and Six and with the exception of Section One, the plats for the other sections state that no fence or improvement may be constructed on a pipeline.

Sunoco has advised us that they will be removing fences that currently encroach on their pipeline easements. Approval given by the Architectural Control Committee for fences located on a pipeline state that a fence may not be placed on the pipeline even if your property line encompasses the pipeline.

If your home backs up to a pipeline and your fence is encroaching on the pipeline easement please make arrangements to relocate your fence prior to having Sunoco take it down. Also, please note that relocation of your fence will require ACC approval. Please submit an HIR prior to relocation.
